The Strathcona Food Bank (SFB) was founded in 1983 and has been **100% volunteer run** since inception. What started as 4 church closet-based operations meeting emergency food needs has grown into a single critical support service for Strathcona county residents.

Food insecurity is a real issue for many families; **our increasing demand** demonstrates it. We believe that everyone in Strathcona County should have **access to healthy food**, and we continue to strive to meet every demand.

Our community provides amazing support. From successful **food drives**, ample regular and special event **volunteers**, to the donations received from community grocery stores and businesses, we celebrate all **partnerships and support**, and recognize we could not do what we do without it.

We continue to grow and develop, and look forward to several initiatives in 2023, including:

- development of an SFB strategic plan
- a new Capital Committee is working to evaluate our current space, and plan for future needs and efficiencies
- new **Fundraising** Committee
- ongoing improvements to our hampers and services
- collaboration with community services to expand accessibility and supports
- **bylaw** revision
